Materials You'll Need

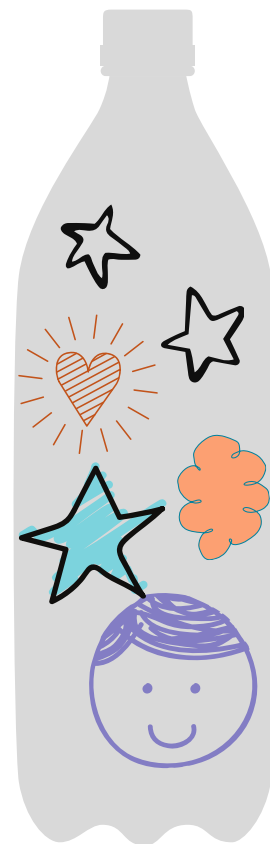
- Empty clean soda bottle (1.75 liter size)
- Pin
- Paint
- Water

Step 1

Gather your materials. Make sure your bottle is clean and dry. Then Paint!

Step 2

Next, use your push pin (with adult supervision) and poke 5-10 holes into the top of the soda can. Fill up your bottle with water and screw your top on and you are ready to water some plants!



Why Recycle?

Recycling is very important for our planet. It is a way to take trash and turn it into new products or even crafts! There are many different types of recycling that allow materials to be used more than once making them multiple-use products. The world tends to create objects and then throw them away, which is bad for the planet. To try and combat this, recycling gives a new purpose to many materials.

Looking at plastic bottles specifically, there are a lot of types of plastics and each type is made from a different combination of chemicals. Once recycled they are cleaned to get rid of any leftover food or other waste. Then, the bottles are crushed or shredded into fine plastic chips which can be melted down to create new plastic or even fiber that is used to make clothing.
