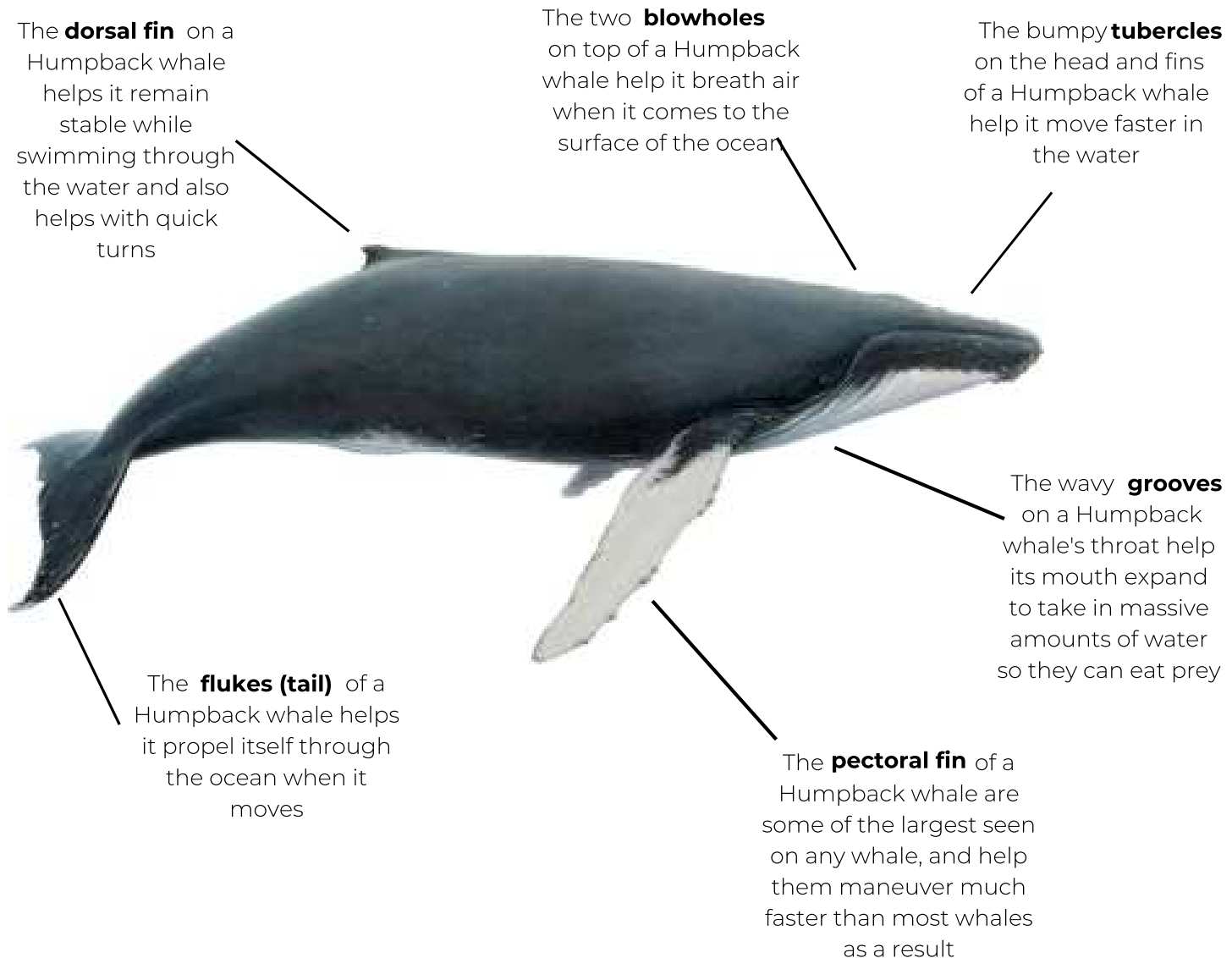




Humpback Whales

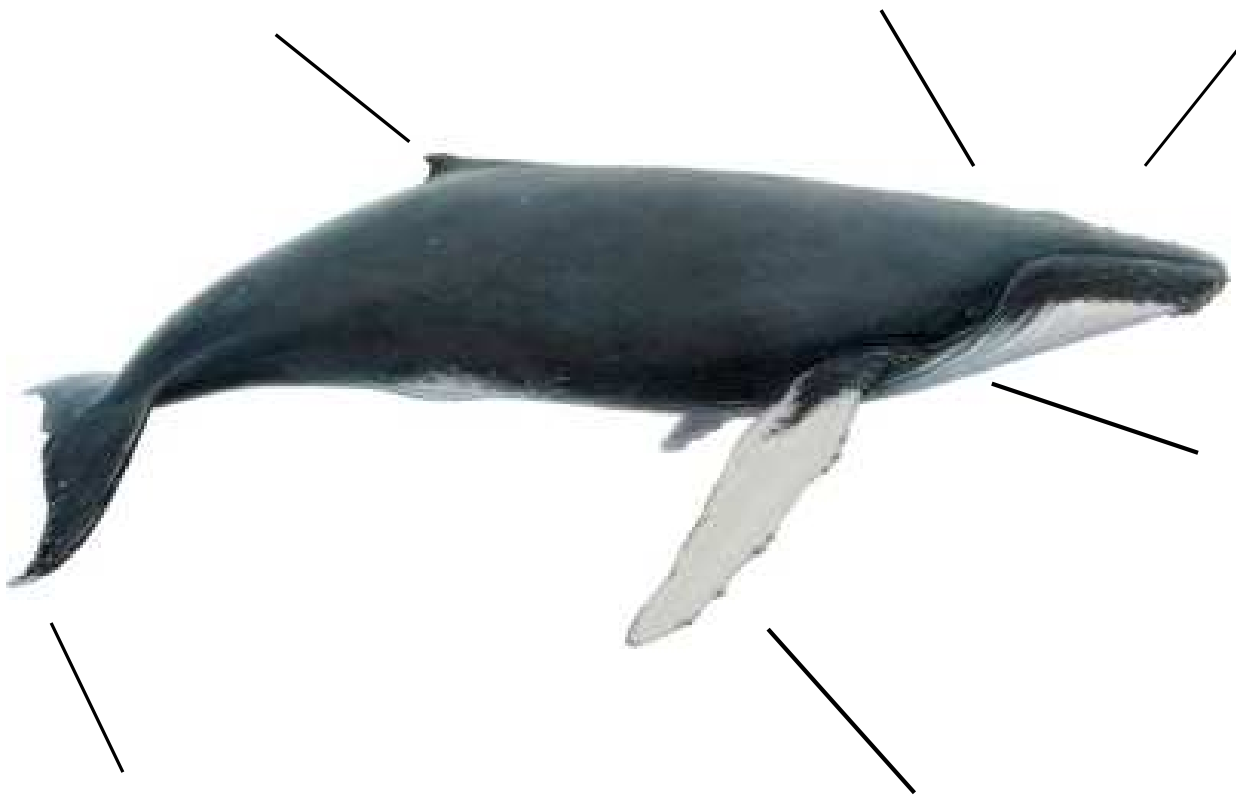
